

Cookies Policy

This Cookies Policy explains how Genting Hong Kong Limited and its subsidiaries, collectively “GHK”, “we”, “us”, “our”, and our corporate affiliates use cookies and similar technologies to recognize you when you visit our websites on which this Cookies Policy is posted and that are GHK-branded or operated by GHK. It explains what these technologies are and why we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

By continuing to use our websites, you consent to our use of cookies in the manner set out in this Cookies Policy.

You will have seen a pop up to this effect on your first visit to our websites; although it will not usually appear on subsequent visits, you may withdraw your consent at any time by following the instructions set out in this Cookies Policy.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating web domain on your subsequent visits to that domain. Most web pages contain elements from multiple web domains so when you visit the website, your browser may receive cookies from several sources.

Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user’s device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and generally improve the user experience. They can also be used to tailor advertising to your interests through tracking your browsing across websites.

2. What types of cookies do we use?

We use different types of cookies. Some cookies are third party cookies - these are cookies that are set by a third party website or applications rather than by us. These third parties may use cookies, but their use of cookies will not be governed by this Cookies Policy.

The cookies used on our websites also can be categorized in four ways in accordance with their purpose: (1) cookies that are strictly necessary; (2) cookies that assist with

the performance of our websites; (3) cookies that record functionality requests; and (4) targeting cookies. Each of these is further explained below.

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies**

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features or they are cookies that are required by law. Without these cookies, services you have asked for (such as navigating between pages) cannot be provided.

- **Performance Cookies**

These cookies collect information about how you use the website and balance website traffic to ensure all users can enjoy consistent and reliable access. For example, they may collect information on which pages you visit most often or if you received an error message from one of the pages on the website. Unless express stated, these cookies do not directly collect information that identifies you. When you provide information that identifies yourself, we may use these cookies to provide relevant information on the website based on information that you have provided and your activities on the website.

- **Functionality Cookies**

These cookies allow the website to remember the choices that you make, such as your user name, language preference, or the region that you are in. The website then uses that information to provide enhanced features. These cookies are not used to track your browsing on other websites.

- **Targeting Cookies**

These cookies collect several pieces of information about your browsing habits. They are usually placed by advertising networks such as Google or Doubleclick. They remember that you have visited the website and share this information with other organizations, such as advertisers. They do this in order to provide you with targeted advertisements that are more relevant to you and your interests. Although these cookies can track your visits to websites on the Internet, the cookies themselves do not usually know who you are. Without these cookies, online advertisements that you encounter will be less relevant to you and your interests.

4. How can you control cookies?

This means that the pop up from our websites will appear. You will need to accept the use of cookies and provide other cookie-related information again.
